

Hull Lifesaving Museum Maritime Program

DESIGNATED WORRIER (DW) PROCEDURES

QUALIFICATIONS:

A designated worrier (DW) must have visited the site and be familiar with the program, building, boats, and safety procedures.

PRE-TRIP PROCEDURE:

The DW must have a blank float plan at home and fill it out completely over the phone.

WHEN THE ESTIMATED TIME OF ARRIVAL HAS PASSED:

- A. If the DW can go the departure area:
 - 1. Go at once
 - 2. Check the float plan
 - 3. Look and check the water for the boat
 - 4. If the boat is not visible:
 - a. Contact the administrative cox
 - b. Call the USCG and report the crew missing giving them the float plan info

- B. If the DW can not go the departure area:
 - 1. Call an administrative cox at once
 - 2. Call the USCG and report the crew missing giving them the float plan info
