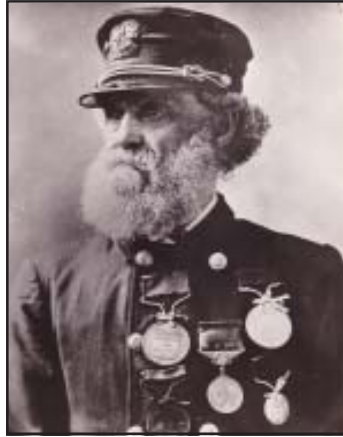

Dramatically situated on the shore at the mouth of Boston Harbor, directly facing Boston light, the Hull Lifesaving Museum is the restored 19th century Point Allerton U.S. Life Saving Station – home of Joshua James and his crew of the most celebrated lifesavers in U.S. history. From the shores of the mighty Atlantic, visitors hear vivid stories of sea voyages, lighthouses, shipwrecks, and rescues while enjoying engaging, hands-on exhibits for people of all ages.

The Maritime Program. Through year-round open-water rowing in Boston Harbor, including programs for adolescents and adults, members can experience, first hand, the values and skills of the 19th century lifesavers – as well as the teamwork and beauty of rowing. The Maritime Program runs after-school, evening, and weekend rowing, and boat-building and education programs for people of all abilities through sites in Hull and downtown Boston and a fleet of large, traditional rowing boats. Our award-winning after-school and job-training initiatives for high-risk youth are national and international program models.
