### **Program**

Our co-ed program is for students ages 12-18. No experience is needed; only enthusiasm and a sense of adventure. Crews will row in traditional open water gigs with four or six rowers. Each boat will be led by an experienced HLM coxswain who provides instruction and is responsible for the safety of the boat.

Every session will include education on the area, the weather, the boats, and rowing. On the occasion that weather does not permit us going out we will have activities planned for indoors.

All crews will meet at The Hull Lifesaving Museum Boathouse at Windmill Point and the Hull Lifesaving Museum, Nantasket Avenue, both in Hull.
