

Hull Lifesaving Museum SUMMER ADVENTURE PROGRAM 2018

The Summer Adventure Program offers six weeks of discovery and exploration for children ages 5-11. From tide pools to pond yachts and mermaids to shipwrecks, kids will explore a different theme each

week! Summer Adventure meets Tuesday-Thursday from 9:30-12:30. Each week includes hands-on activities, outdoor exploration, and a fun mix of history, science, and arts. Visit www.hullifesavingmuseum.org for more information.

Session 1, Shipwrecks and Lifesavers, July 10-12 (\$90 members/\$110 nonmembers)

Walk in the footsteps of Captain Joshua James and his crew, exploring daily life at the historic Lifesaving Station. We'll learn about Boston Harbor's most amazing storms and shipwrecks, hear stories of courageous rescues, and have a chance to ride the breeches buoy!

Session 2, Tide Pool Adventures I, July 17-19 (\$90 members/\$110 nonmembers)

Always a highlight of the summer, we'll explore the wonderful tidal pools within a short walk of the museum, learning to slow down, look closely, and find the wealth of plant and animal life in a single small pool.

Session 3, A Sailors Life, July 24-26 (\$90 members/\$110 nonmembers)

Aye, Aye! Welcome aboard! Life aboard a schooner in the early 1900's wasn't easy but was surely an adventure! Explore a day in the life of sailors aboard the schooners that were found sailing in and out of Boston Harbor regularly.

Session 4, Pond Yachts, July 31- August 2 (\$100 members/\$120 nonmembers)

A great opportunity for young children to build their first model boat-a T12 that sails beautifully. Children will assemble, paint, and rig their vessels from a high quality T12 model boat kit.

Session 5, Seafaring Pets, August 7-9 (\$90 members/\$110 nonmembers)

Learn about cats in life jackets and dogs in Coast Guard uniforms! We'll learn about local heroes, Roger the Coast Guard dog and Sammy the Boston Lighthouse dog as well as many other animal friends at sea!

Session 6, Tide Pool Adventures II, August 14-16(\$90 members/\$110 nonmembers)

We will continue our exploration of the rich intertidal zone on local beaches, investigating our finds with nets and magnifiers. We'll learn about sea stars, anemones, crustaceans and more! (It is not necessary to have participated in Tide Pool Adventures I to participate in this session).
