SLIDING SEAT BOATS: NEW RULES!

Below, please see the New Rules/Guidelines for all sliding seat boats at the Snow Row, developed by HLM's Safety Committee and Gary Piantedosi, from ALDEN, to assure the safety and integrity of the sliders at the Snow Row.

- 1. Bow Numbers (and clips) provided by Alden
- 2. Every slider wears a lifejacket not just stored in the boat the water is cold!
- 3. This cannot be your first open water race. We will need you to tell us where you have raced before.
- 4. Bailers/buckets are required for all open cockpit boats, attached by a lanyard.
- 5. **All** Long skinny boats ie. 7 to 1 length to beam ratio (Maas, Alden Star, Echo Ace, Peinert Dolphin) **must be fitted with pontoons**. Alden will bring 10 sets for loaners. This applies to **all** in this class.
- 6. This is a race for singles and doubles only, no quads. (This does not include the Mainville-type boats from Cohasset).
- 8. A Whistle or air-horn mandatory in each boat.
